

## Geneviève Reday-Mulvey



**Geneviève Reday-Mulvey**, a social economist of French nationality, is, since 1987, head of the Four Pillars Research Programme on Social Security, Pensions and Employment of The Geneva Association (International Association for the Study of Insurance Economics).

She is the editor of *The Four Pillars Research Newsletter* and is editor of regular issues on the four pillars of *The Geneva Papers on Risk and Insurance*. In 1996, she co-edited a book on Gradual Retirement in the OECD Countries. She has written multiple articles and chapters of books on this issue for specialised publications and is also the author of *The Future of Pensions and Retirement: 10 Key Questions*, published in French in 2000 and in English in 2002 by GINA & The Geneva Association. In 2005 she published *Working beyond 60 - Key Policies and Practices in Europe* (Palgrave Macmillan, London). She has also recently contributed to the European Commission research on these issues and to the Swiss federal reports on pensions.
