

Accepting applications for the 2022 Geneva Association Ernst Meyer Prize

The Geneva Association awards the prestigious Geneva Association Ernst Meyer Prize annually for university research work in the form of a **doctoral thesis** that makes a significant and original contribution to the study of **risk and insurance economics**.

Requirements:

- The thesis should **have been accepted by the PhD Committee** during the calendar year preceding the submission deadline.
- Submissions are possible in one of the following languages: **English, French, Spanish, German**.
- The prize is **CHF 5,000**.
- The deadline for applications is **21 January 2022**.

Applications for the award should be addressed to secretariat@genevaassociation.org and **include all of the following:**

- An electronic version (PDF) of the thesis
- An English language abstract of 1,000–1,200 words
- Two recommendations (written in English), each providing a review of the submitted work
- A curriculum vitae in English.
