Ronnie Klein is the Director of The Geneva Association's Global Ageing programme. His responsibilities include developing and publishing papers and articles on global ageing, leading the GA's Global Ageing Conference, managing the industry working group on global ageing and representing The Geneva Association at conferences and meetings. In addition, he is the Secretariat for the Global Reinsurance Forum (GRF), an association comprised of the CEOs from the top 13 reinsurance companies. Ronnie's research approach aims to provide workable solutions to mitigating global risks related to ageing.

Prior to joining The Geneva Association, Ronnie was the Head of Protection Pricing and Head of Reinsurance for the Life Division of Zurich Insurance Group. He was also the Head of Life Reinsurance at AIG in New York, where he structured internal and external reinsurance solutions. In addition, Ronnie worked for the Life Division of Swiss Re in New York and London as the Head of Global Pricing and Head of Marketing for North America. While at Swiss Re, he developed and patented the first mortality bond called Vita.

Ronnie began his career at the Mutual Life Insurance Company of New York, occupying various roles in agent compensation, health insurance and reinsurance. He is a fellow and past board member of the Society of Actuaries and a member of the American Academy of Actuaries. Ronnie graduated from Binghamton University with honors.
